

13. HYDROPONICS FARMING

Hydroponics Farming technique have been initiated by the IQAC at our college to enrich our college environment. Due to heavy salt deposits near the beach, traditional planting became difficult. By utilizing soilless cultivation methods, hydroponics offers a solution. The IQAC played a pivotal role in implementing this initiative successfully. The

hydroponic technique has enabled us to overcome soil limitations and foster a greener and more sustainable environment

14. WASTE DECOMPOSER

The IQAC at our college has an initiative to convert organic waste into valuable manual. Decomposers, also known as organic waste decomposers, play a crucial role in breaking down organic matter into valuable compost. These decomposers consist of beneficial microorganisms that accelerate the decomposition process. To culture the decomposer the following method is followed. 200 liters of water with 2 kg of jiggery a, added with basen or any powdered 2 Kg of pulses and with addition to it 1 box of waste decomposer is the culture medium for the growth of micro organism extracted to get the organic decomposer and utilized for plantation. This is very economical and purely organic. It has been purchased from Ghaziabad, Delhi. This method of utilizing organic waste for the production of a decomposer is highly economical and environmentally friendly. By diverting organic waste from landfills and transforming it into a valuable resource, we contribute to sustainable waste management and reduce the environmental impact of waste.
